

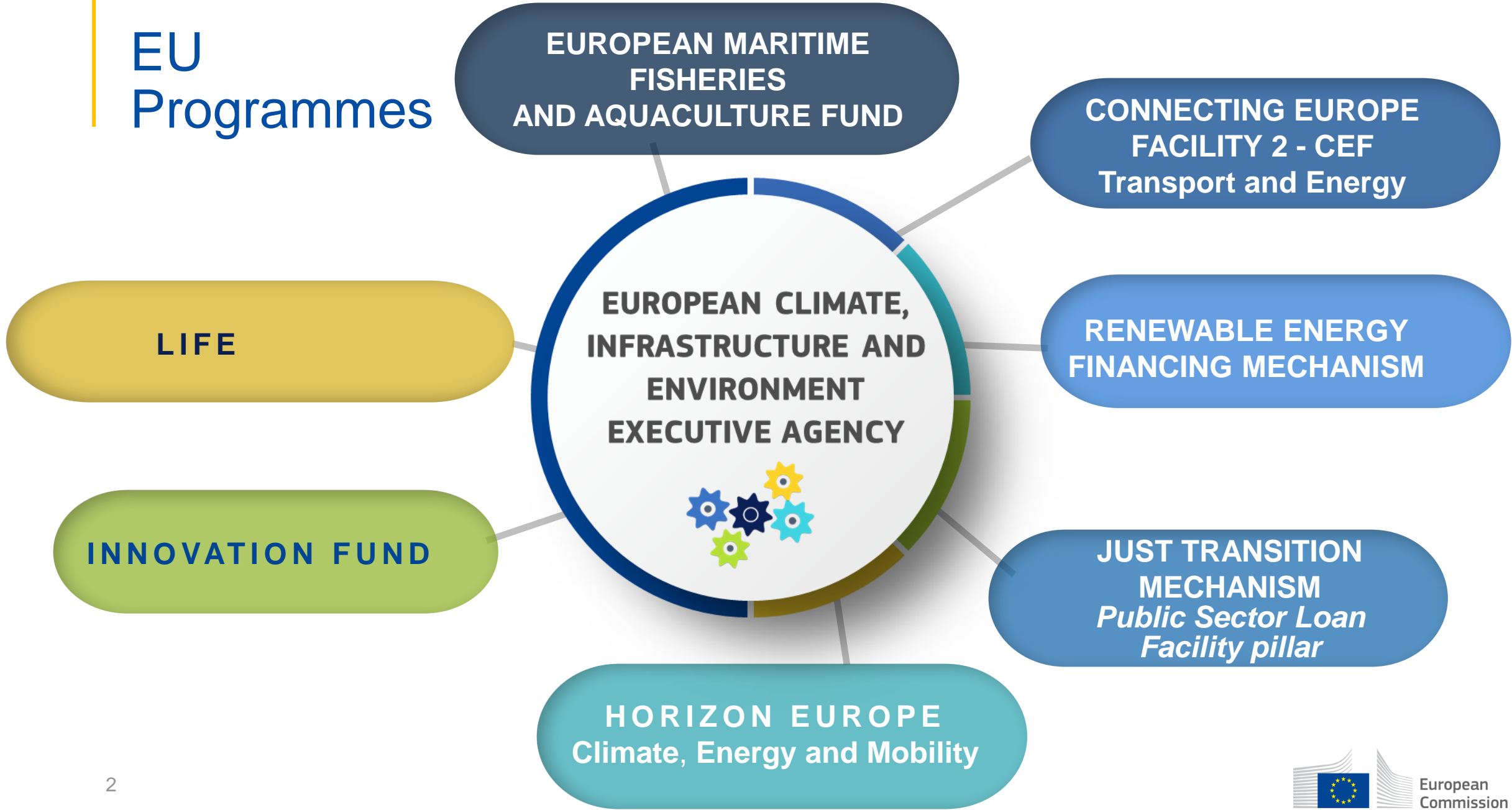

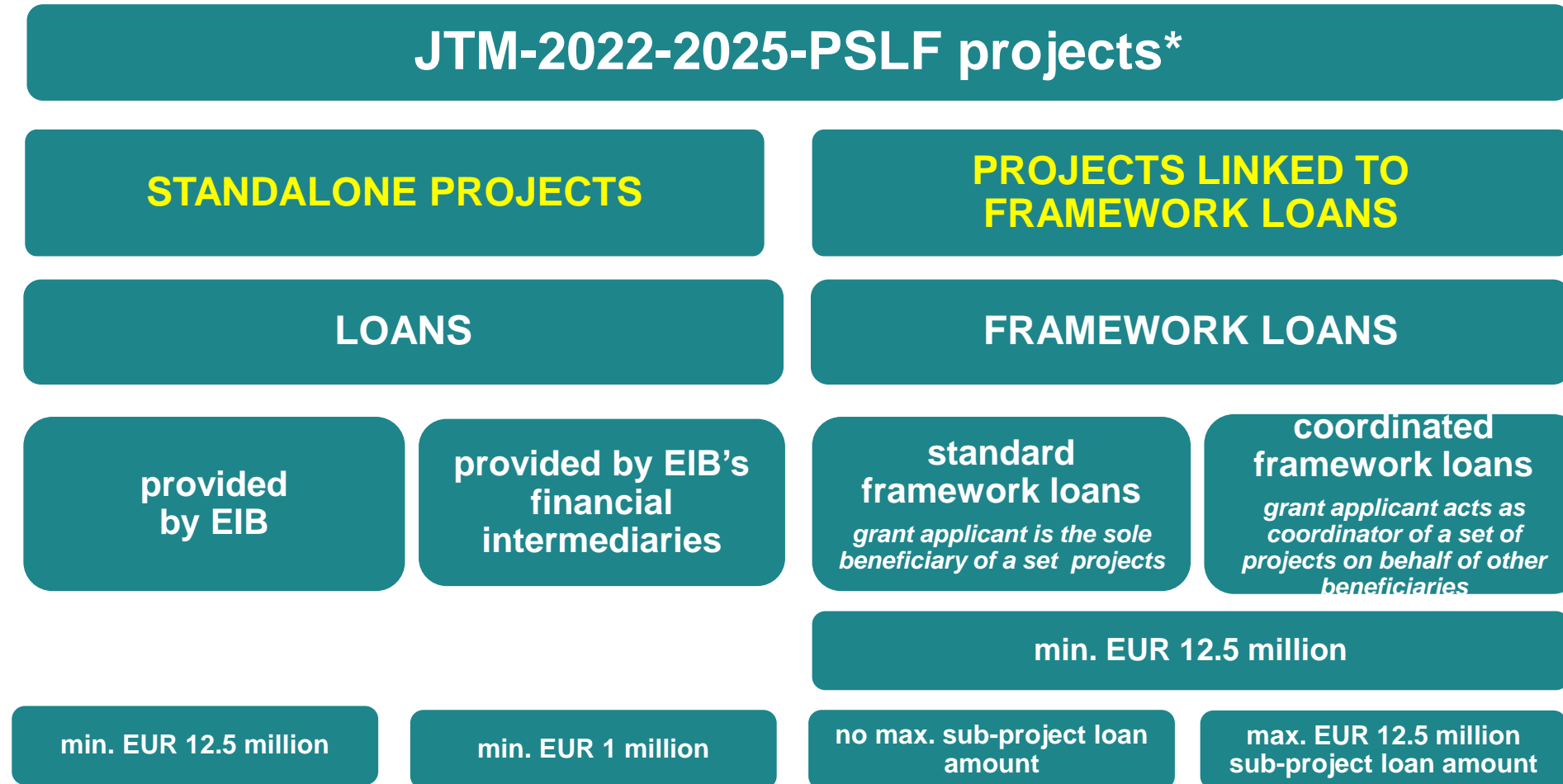

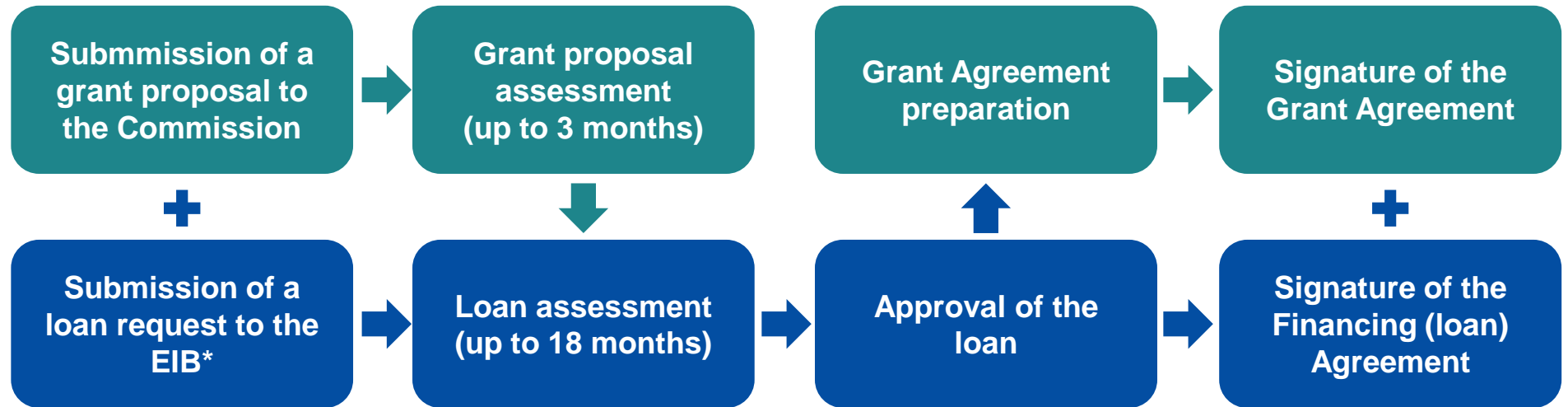
Call for proposals - JTM-2022-2025-PSLF

2 topics



* The **grant amount** is determined as a percentage of the loan: 15% or 25% for less developed regions

Grant application process



*before or in parallel to the submission of the grant proposal

Grant application process

1. **Call for proposals** by the Commission (with submission deadlines)
2. **Submission of the proposals by the project promoters**
3. **If framework loan:** start preparation of an EIB framework loan before submission
4. **Submission + 15 days:** Assessment of the proposals by the Commission against the admissibility and eligibility requirements
5. **Submission + 3 months:** Assessment of the proposals by the Commission against **selection, exclusion, award** and **prioritisation criteria**, including the compliance with the relevant Territorial Just Transition Plans
6. **Submission + maximum 18 months:** Assessment of the proposals by the EIB
7. Finalisation of the **Grant Agreement** by the Commission
8. Finalisation and signature of the **Financing Agreement** by the EIB

Successful applicants will be invited by CINEA to prepare the Grant Agreement (preparation process approx. 3 months)

Grant application - guidance

- Proposals must be submitted **electronically via the Funding & Tender Portal**.
- All beneficiaries, affiliated entities and associated partners **must be registered in the [Participant Register](#)** before submitting an application.
- **Proposal title acronym:** Year-Submission(cut-off) date-Country-Topic-Project, example: 2025-8-PL-SP-Tychy
- Applicant must use **the forms and the templates provided** in the system
- ✓ **Part A:** general information such as title, duration, abstract, participants, grant amount (to be filled out directly online)
- ✓ **Part B: a technical description of the proposal** (up to 100 pages a word doc.) + **calculator + SBP/simplified business plan** + CVs of core project team + a list of previous projects + a decarbonization plan (if available) + activity reports of last year + a proof of public service mission for private entities (to be downloaded, completed, assembled and re-uploaded as PDFs)
- ✓ **Part C:** KPIs related to GHG emissions reduction, job creation, people reached, as well as private and/or public financing, sectors, environmental impacts, loan (to be filled out directly online)

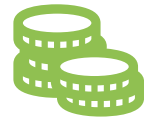
